1. The Government of Uganda has allocated funds to be utilised for the acquisition of consultancy services to independent quality assurance of the Human Capital Management (HCM) System.

The major objective of the assignment is to provide end to end Quality Assurance Services during the implementation of the HCM System in Phase 3, post-implementation, and support and warranty period with the aim of ensuring the implementers of the system successfully achieve the intended deliverables and milestones as stipulated in the HCM contract and third-party contracts. This will require the consultant to independently verify that all aspects of the HCM project are evaluated for compliance with recommended industry standards and best practices; a series of inspections, reviews and tests are conducted throughout the implementation of the application; and planned activities are conducted with the aim of providing confidence that the HCM operates as per the Government requirements in the Bid to increase adoption and utilization. The consultant will provide advisory and assurance services on all functional, technical, security, performance, operational and transitional matters relating to the efficient and successful execution of the project and HCM utilization.

- 2. The Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development Resource Enhancement and Accountability Programme (REAP) hereby invites sealed proposals from eligible **consultancy firms** to provide the aforementioned services.
- 3. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the Open Domestic Bidding procurement method and is open to eligible consultancy firms.

- 4. Interested consultancy firms may obtain further information and inspect the proposal documents at the address given below at 8(a) from 0800 1700hrs (Kampala Time) on working days.
- 5. The Request for proposals document may be acquired on submission of a written application to the address below at 8(a), and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Shs50,000 (Shillings Fifty Thousand only). Interested consultancy firms may make payment to the URA collection account at commercial banks. The **bank advice and the application** shall be presented for issue of the Request for Proposal Document, to the address below at 8(a).
- 6. Proposals must be delivered to the address below at 8(b), at or before 1100hrs (Kampala Time) on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2024. Late proposals shall be rejected. Proposals will be opened in the presence of the consultants' representatives who choose to attend the meeting on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2024 at 1120hrs.
