##### **2.3 (2) Step 2 - Negotiated phase: Opening and Administrative Checks and Evaluation of the Full Application**

“Upon a common understanding and agreement on the content of the action, the selected applicants will be invited to prepare and submit a full proposal within a period of 45 days (Part B of the grant application form)”.

**It has been changed to:**

“Upon a common understanding and agreement on the content of the action, the selected applicants will be invited to prepare and submit a full proposal within a period of 30 days (Part B of the grant application form)”.
